We also wanted to update you on how the money we raise is spent - as every penny goes to the school to use on the things that they need. We help with big and small things - but everything is focused on helping our children in the best way we can.

This year we have used the money for 3 creative workshops that the whole school join in with. These workshops support the curriculum and we know that the children love this different way of learning. This year the kids have enjoyed an art workshop, a dance workshop and this week an African drumming workshop.

The PTA funds also paid for the children to go to the Pantomime last Christmas which is always an adventure and for something a little more relaxing, they experienced a Yoga afternoon recently in each of their classes.

Every year the funds also pay for the transport for school trips so that the parents don't need to pay extra.

Plus, we have also paid for:
