Red Nose Day

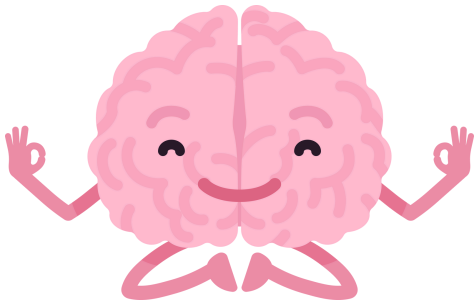
